



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

B2C PHASE I: July 8, 2020, Macon Cove and Union Avenue campuses reopen for career and technical classes with a lab. Only students taking select courses, assigned faculty, essential employees and vendors are allowed on campus. Campuses remain closed to the public. Common areas (library, cafeteria and bookstore) remain closed. The online bookstore and all other classes and services remain virtual. No on-campus events.

GAINING ACCESS TO CAMPUS: LET'S KEEP EACH OTHER SAFE!

1. Take the online [health assessment](#) BEFORE you come to campus and on the same day you come to campus. If you pass the health assessment, you will receive a pass via text or email or you can print it. Bring the pass to campus with you.
2. Arrive early. Be prepared to wear a mask and gloves.
3. When you arrive on campus, follow directional signage to park your vehicle. If arriving by bus or walking onto campus, immediately proceed to the health screening area.
4. Participate in the health screening by presenting your health assessment pass and getting your body temperature scanned.
5. Your temperature must not be higher than 100.6 degrees. If it is higher, you will be retested. If you fail the retest, you cannot be admitted to campus.
6. If you pass the screening, pick up a mask and gloves (if you don't have them already).
7. You may now access the campus. You must wear a mask and gloves and practice proper hand washing and social distancing while on campus.
8. If you leave and return to campus the same day, you will have to take another health screening.
9. These health precautions are subject to change in response to COVID-19 conditions.
